The event will be broadcast via Facebook and YouTube.

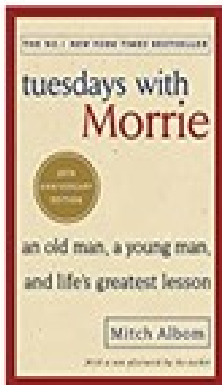
THORNTON WATLASS LENT LUNCH in the Village Hall on Saturday 5th March from 12noon until 1.30pm. All Welcome.

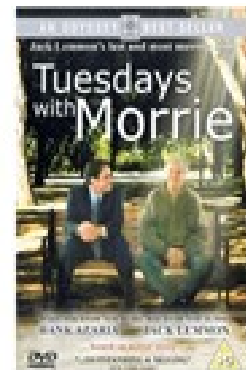

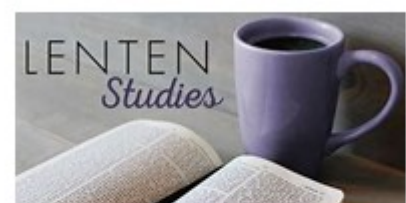
through it? For Mitch Albom, that person was Morrie Schwartz, his college professor from nearly twenty years ago.

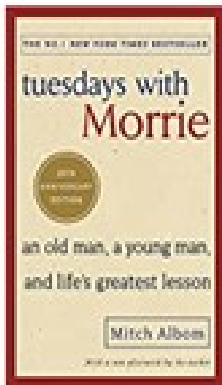

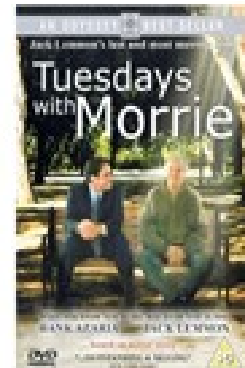

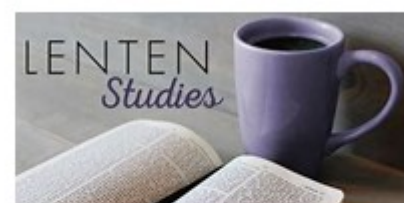
